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Aim

- *To create a space for shared learning and idea sharing within the improvement community for those involved in delivering Improvement*

Plan

- *The network was set up by Andrew Seaton at Gloucestershire Safety & Quality Improvement Academy (GSQIA) at the end of 2018, as a space to share ideas and learning, following visits to GSQIA by other organisations. Over the last 2 years the network has grown with membership now across England, connecting improvers together around common interests and challenges.*

In the first year the network met centrally to the region in Bristol, 4 times per year with dial in accessibility. As a result of Covid, this network has moved to a virtual meeting which has had a direct impact on the number of people who are able to attend meetings and share their work, from a much wider geographical region. It has been agreed by the group that this network should continue virtually beyond Covid. Communications are shared between the network in between the quarterly meetings. This network continues to grow and its value is felt by its members.
