Project aim

Using innovative training solutions to raise awareness of dementia and its impact on patients by empowering our staff and Doctors to provide the best dementia care possible.

Dementia is the no.1 cause of death nationally and 1 person in 8 currently dies from dementia . Dementia effects approx. 25% of our patients at any one time, therefore we hope to:

- Improve the patient and carer experience
- Give staff an insight into how dementia effects people
- Optimise our clinical and non-clinical interventions through person-centred training sessions

Results

Virtual dementia tour experienced by **737** staff members as of September 2018.

Dementia awareness training has 96% compliance Trust wide

63 Doctors from Junior to Consultant have experienced the VDT with one Consultant exclaiming "Its changed all I thought I knew about dementia" Further bespoke doctor Training sessions to Commence October 2019
