Measures

Initial measures for compliance with TEP forms used for all patients with DNACPR form in place From August will be for all adult in-patients using data from Perfect Ward

Tests for change

Review and update Treatment Escalation Plans to be used for all adult in-patients

- Involve stakeholders to agree final version of form
- Facilitate printing and provision of updated forms
- Update TEP policy to include expectation that completed for all adult in-patients
- Add TEP forms to Netteswell (SDAU) Admission pack
- Add requirement to pre-operative checklist
- Ensure available in all assessment areas

Results

This demonstrates improved compliance against full completion of TEP forms (including MCA for those patients with DNACPR in place.

Once new forms are in place the compliance is likely to drop initially as will be measured against all adult inpatients



Learning and next steps

The new forms are due to be rolled out in October 2019 and going forward compliance will be monitored against all adult in-patients.
